Through the instant petition preferred under Article 226/227 of the Constitution of India, petitioner has sought a writ in the nature of mandamus directing the respondents to grant all the retiral benefits to him along-with interest @ 12% per annum on the delayed payment(s) thereof in view of full Bench judgment of this Court in the case of R.S. Randhawa vs. State of Punjab, 1997 (3) RSJ 318 WITH FURTHER direction to respondents to grant him proficiency step up after 8, 16/4, 9, 14 years of service and fix his salary as well as revised the retiral benefits and also to make payment of outstanding salary of ₹2,00,000/- due to him.

2. At the very outset of arguments, it has been submitted by learned counsel for the petitioner that a legal notice dated January 09, 2018 (P-7) was served upon the respondents but till date no conscious decision has been taken.

He further submits that he feels satisfied in case a direction is issued to respondents to consider and decide the afore-said legal notice dated January 09, 2018 (P-7) within some stipulated period.

3. Without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case, instant petition is disposed of with a direction to respondents to look into the grievances unfolded by the petitioner in the legal notice dated January 09, 2018 (P-7) and to decide the same in accordance with law, rules and regulations within a period of three months from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order.

4. However, in case petitioner still feels aggrieved by any order of the afore-said authority he shall be at liberty to have recourse to the other remedies available to him under law including to approach this Court.
