The present petition has been filed for issuance of a writ in the nature of *mandamus* directing the respondent authorities to take action against respondent No.5 as a complaint was made by the petitioner and certain documents were also supplied but still no action has been taken.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that a complaint/representation was made to the respondent authorities on 17.10.2016 and thereafter, a reminder was sent on 05.12.2016 but still no action has been taken. Learned counsel further submits that the petitioner would be satisfied, in case, the directions are issued by this Court to consider the pending representation dated 17.10.2016 (Annexure P-5) moved by him.

Keeping in view the limited prayer of the petitioner and without commenting anything on the merits of the case, the present petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No.2 to take action on the pending representation dated 17.10.2016 (Annexure P-5) in accordance with law after hearing the parties concerned within a period of four weeks from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order.

The petition is disposed of accordingly.
