The challenge in this petition filed under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India is to the condition contained in Clause 4(ii) of the tender Document (**Annexure P-1**) and corrigendum dated 12.02.2018 (**Annexure P-2**) providing ultra-vires condition to be inserted in the tender document.

2. At the outset, learned counsel for the petitioner submitted that as per information received by him, the respondents are considering the case of the petitioner regarding change of condition contained in Clause 4(ii) of the tender document. Accordingly, a prayer was made that he may be allowed to withdraw the present writ petition at this stage with liberty to the petitioner to approach this Court again after the tenders are opened, in case any grievance survives.
