In the nature of order I propose to pass, no formal written statement(s)/counter-affidavit(s) on behalf of the respondents are indeed necessary at this stage. Thus, with the consent of learned counsel for the parties, the petition is being finally disposed of.

The petitioner is employed as Conductor with the respondent-department. Pursuant to an order dated 20.2.2017 (Annexure P-1), he was transferred from Rohtak to Ambala, and in compliance thereof, he joined at his new place of posting. However, within less than four months, he was again transferred to Jhajjar, vide order dated 12.6.2017. Not just that, vide impugned order dated 12.2.2018 (Annexure P-3), he has been re-transferred to Ambala. Although, the petitioner has questioned his transfer on multiple grounds, but, concededly, he has since been relieved from Jhajjar.

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In response, learned State counsel submits that in the matter involving similar issues, as regards transfer of the employees of the Transport Department, Haryana, this Court, vide order and judgment dated 01.09.2017 (Annexure P-6), as also the judgment dated 12.12.2017, rendered in **CWP No.24190 of 2017 (Dilbag Singh Vs. State of Haryana and others)** and other connected matters [Annexure P-7], had issued comprehensive directions to the department to deal with similar issues. Thus, he submits that the grievance/claim of the petitioner shall be considered in terms thereof, and respondents shall pass appropriate orders within six weeks from today.

That beings so, learned counsel for the petitioner submits that nothing substantive survives in this petition and the same be disposed of in the above terms.

Ordered accordingly.
