The petitioners were appointed as part-time Sweepers between 01.09.1999 to 06.11.2002. Their services were regularized on 25.08.2014, 15.05.2017, 22.07.2017 & 31.08.2017, respectively. The limited grievance that they have is that services of the persons junior to them, who were appointed much later, were regularized by the respondent-department w.e.f. 01.04.2011. And, thus the petitioners too ought to have been regularized from the same date. Petitioners purport to have served the respondents with a legal notice dated 16.10.2017 (Annexure P6), but that too has failed to evoke any response. And no result is in sight either.

That being so, the petition is disposed of, at this stage, only with a direction to the respondent authority to consider and decide the notice dated 16.10.2017 (Annexure P6), within a period of three months from the receipt of certified copy of this order. And pass appropriate orders in accordance with law. In the event, the claim of the petitioners is declined,

the respondent authority shall pass a comprehensive order assigning reasons
in support thereof.
