JASPAL SINGH, J (ORAL)

By virtue of instant petition preferred under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India, petitioner has sought a writ in the nature of mandamus directing the respondents No. 2 to 4 to decide the representation dated December 14, 2017 (P-3).

2. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the case of petitioner is squarely covered under the guidelines laid down by the Division Bench of this Court in the case of *Harbans Lal vs. State of Punjab and others; 2012 (3) SCT 362* and the same relief has already been extended to similarly situated employees by this Court in CWP No. 24472 of 2015, titled as *Constable Rajesh Kumar and another vs. State of Punjab and another*, decided on January 07, 2016. He further submits that petitioner moved representation dated December 14, 2017 (P-3) to respondent No.2 but despite the fact that a period of more than

two months has elapsed, no action has been taken so far. He further submits that he feels satisfied in case a direction is issued to respondent No.2 to consider and decide the representation (P-3) within some stipulated period

3. In the light of afore-said facts and circumstances but without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case, the instant petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No.2 to look into the grievances unfolded by the petitioner in her representation dated December 14, 2017 (P-3) and to take a conscious decision in accordance with law, rules and regulations as well as in view of judgments referred in para 2 of this order, within a period of four months from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order.

4. In case the petitioner still feels aggrieved, she shall be at liberty to have recourse to the other remedies available under law including to approach this Court.
