DAYA CHAUDHARY, J.

The petitioner is aggrieved in not taking decision by respondent No.2 on the basis of regular inquiry report dated 14.8.2017.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that on the basis of complaint made by the petitioner against respondent No.5, regular inquiry was conducted and allegations were found to be proved but still no action has been taken on the basis of inquiry report dated 14.8.2017. Learned counsel further submits that the petitioner would be satisfied in case directions are issued to respondent No.2 to take action on the basis of aforesaid inquiry report.

Keeping in view the limited prayer of the petitioner and without commenting anything on the merits of the case, the present petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No.2 to take action on the inquiry report dated 14.8.2017, annexed as Annexure P-3 with the petition, in accordance with law within a period of four weeks from the date of receipt of a certified copy of the order.
