By virtue of instant petition preferred under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India, petitioner has sought a writ in the nature of mandamus directing the respondents to allow him perform a promotion at the level of Engineer-in-Chief in the Irrigation Department, Haryana w.e.f. the date his junior officer, late Sh. M.K. Gupta, was promoted as Engineer-in-Chief vide government order Memo dated October 29, 2007 (P-2).

2. Petitioner submits that he has not been given the proforma promotion to the level of Engineer-in-Chief in the Irrigation Department, Haryana w.e.f. the date his junior officer, late Sh. M.K. Gupta was promoted vide order dated October 29, 2007 (P-2) despite the fact that he was having an outstanding service record. He stood retired on November 30, 2007. He further submits that he sent a representation dated February 19, 2017 (P-8) to the respondent and subsequent thereto, its reminder dated October 31, 2017 (P-9) but till date

no action has been taken. He further submits that he feels satisfied in case a direction is issued to respondent to consider and decide the representation (P-8) within some time bound manner.

3. Without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case, the instant petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent to look into the grievances unfolded by the petitioner in his representation dated February 19, 2017 (P-8) and to take a conscious decision within a period of three months from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order.

4. In case the petitioner still feels aggrieved, he shall be at liberty to have recourse to the other remedies available under law including to approach this Court.
