This writ petition under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India has been filed for the issuance of a writ, in the nature of mandamus directing the respondents to consider the petitioner for re-employment as Computer Operator in Panchayat Samiti, Sangrur.

Contents that case of the petitioner is covered by a judgment passed by this Court in CWP-9381-2007, titled as “**Gagandeep Singh and others Vs. State of Punjab and others**” decided on 15.09.2011 (Annexure P-10). Further he states that at this stage he would be satisfied, if a direction is issued to respondent No.2- Director, Rural Development and Panchayats Department, Punjab, Vikas Bhawan, Sector-62, SAS Nagar, Mohali to consider and decide the letter/representation dated 18.12.2017 (Annexure P-9) in view of Annexure P-10.

Heard.

In view of the above, without adverting to the merits of the

case, the present petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No.2-Director, Rural Development and Panchayats Department, Punjab, Vikas Bhawan, Sector-62, SAS Nagar, Mohali to consider and decide the letter/representation dated 18.12.2017 (Annexure P-9) in view of Annexure P-10 within six weeks from the receipt of the certified copy of the order. In case, on consideration, the competent authority reaches to the conclusion that the benefit claimed by the petitioner is admissible to him, in such eventuality, the consequential relief be allowed to him, within a period of six weeks thereafter. However, in case the competent authority feels that the relief claimed by the petitioner is not admissible or made out, in that case, a speaking order be passed in the matter.
