by passing a speaking order, within a period of three months from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order. In case after passing the order, it is found that the petitioner is entitled for any monetary benefits, the same should also be released to her within a period of three months thereafter.

Present writ petition stands disposed of accordingly.
