In the nature of order I propose to pass, no formal written
statement(s)/counter-affidavit(s) on behalf of the respondents are indeed
necessary at this stage. Thus, with the consent of learned counsel for the
parties, the petition is being finally disposed of.

The petitioners are employed as drivers with the respondent-
department, and are aggrieved by multiple transfers, they have been
subjected to, which are alleged to be violative of the transfer
policy/guidelines, dated 6.10.2005 (Annexure P-4).

In response, learned State counsel submits that in the matter
involving similar issues, as regards transfer of the employees of the

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Transport Department, Haryana, this Court, vide order and judgment dated 01.09.2017, as also the judgment dated 12.12.2017, rendered in **CWP No.24190 of 2017 (Dilbag Singh Vs. State of Haryana and others)** and other connected matters, had issued comprehensive directions to the department to deal with similar issues. Thus, he submits that the grievance/claim of the petitioners shall be considered in terms thereof, and respondents shall pass appropriate orders within four weeks from today.

That beings so, learned counsel for the petitioners submits that nothing substantive survives in this petition and the same be disposed of in the above terms.
