The petitioner claims that he is an affected person within the meaning of Section 3(c) (ii) of the Right to Fair Compensation and Transparency in Land Acquisition, Rehabilitation and Resettlement Act, 2013 and would thus be entitled to fair compensation on account of the acquisition of the land on which he is a lessee for the last three years.

Without commenting on the veracity of the claim or the merits of the petition but noticing the fact that representations have been made by the petitioner which are pending before the competent authority, we deem it appropriate to dispose of the instant petition with a direction to respondent No.4 to consider and decide the representations (Annexure P-8 and P-9) as expeditiously as possible. Ordered accordingly.

In case the claim of the petitioner is well founded, the necessary consequences of the acquisition available to an affected

person be afforded to him within six months of decision of his representation.

Petition stands disposed of.
