Petitioner-Gram Panchayat is aggrieved by the inaction of the respondent-authorities as no action has been taken to remove the illegal possession over its land. An eviction petition was filed, which was decided in favour of petitioner-Gram Panchayat and possession thereof was handed over on the spot on 26.10.2016 by the Tehsildar after getting that land vacated and it was given on lease through Panchayat but within few days only, illegal possession was made on the land in dispute and in spite of making representation, no action has been taken.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that an application dated 20.06.2017 (Annexure P-5/T) was moved before respondent No.5 but the same is still pending and no action has been taken.

Keeping in view the limited prayer of the petitioner and by considering the averments made in the petition, the present petition is

disposed of with a direction to respondent No.5 to take action on the pending application/ representation in accordance with law within a period of four weeks from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order.
