The petitioner was employed by the respondent-department on part-time basis on 07.06.1985 (Annexure P1), whereafter her services were regularized w.e.f. 23.08.2014 as Mali-cum-Waterman, pursuant to an order dated 21.08.2014 (Annexure P9). The limited grievance that she has is; that in terms of the regularization policy dated 30.12.1998/25.02.1999 (Annexure P2), her services ought to have been regularized w.e.f. 27.01.1999/01.02.1999. She purports to have even served the respondents with a legal notice dated 28.07.2017 (Annexure P10). But to no avail.

That being so, the petition is disposed of, at this stage, only with a direction to the respondents to consider and decide the claim/grievance of the petitioner, as also the legal notice dated 28.07.2017 (Annexure P10), within a period of 3 months from the receipt of certified copy of this order. And pass appropriate orders in accordance with law. Needless to assert that in the event the claim of the petitioner is declined, the

respondent-authorities shall pass a comprehensive order assigning reasons in support thereof.
