The present case has been filed by the petitioner seeking the release of arrears of pension and other pensionary benefits for which the husband of the petitioner was entitled for.

Learned counsel for the petitioner states that he will be satisfied, at this stage, if the respondents are directed to decide his representation (Annexure P-5) dated 15.06.2017.

In view of the request made by counsel for the petitioner, the present writ petition is disposed of by directing the respondents to decide representation (Annexure P-5) dated 15.06.2017 filed by the petitioner, within a period of three months from the date of receipt of copy of this order.

It is made clear that this Court expresses no opinion on merits and the claim being made by the petitioner in this regard.

In case, after the decision, it is found that the petitioner is entitled for monetary benefits, the same should also be released within three months thereafter.

The writ petition is disposed of.
