ARUN PALLI, J. (ORAL)

The petitioners are employed as part-time Sweepers with the respondent-department, and their services were regularised in the year 2014. The limited grievance that they have is; that services of number of employees, who were appointed subsequent to the petitioners, have since been regularised w.e.f. 1.4.2011. Thus, it is contended that the petitioners too ought to have been regularised from the date services of their juniors were regularised. The petitioners purport to have even served the respondents with a legal notice, dated 19.12.2017 (Annexure P-5). But to no avail.

That being so, the petition is disposed of, at this stage, only with a direction to the respondents to consider and decide the claim/grievance of the petitioners, as also their legal notice, dated 19.12.2017 (Annexure P-5), within a period of three months from the receipt

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of certified copy of this order. And pass appropriate orders in accordance with law. In the event, the claim of the petitioners is declined, the authority shall pass a comprehensive order assigning reasons in support thereof.
