JASPAL SINGH, J

Through instant petition preferred under Article 226/227 of the Constitution of India, petitioner has sought issuance of a writ especially in the nature of mandamus, directing the respondents to fix the pension of the petitioner and release gratuity and arrears of pension along with interest @ 15% per annum.

2. At the very outset of the arguments, learned counsel for the petitioner submits that petitioner feels satisfied in case direction is issued to respondent No. 2, to decide representation dated 04.12.2017 (Annexure P-3), within a stipulated period.

3. Without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case, the instant petition is disposed of with the direction to respondent No.2-Director General of Police, Punjab, Punjab Police Head Quarters, Sector 9, Chandigarh,

to consider all the aspects mentioned in the representation dated 04.12.2017 (Annexure P-3) and take a conscious decision in accordance with law and Rules, within a period of three months from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order.

4. However, if the petitioner still feels aggrieved against any of the order(s) passed by the concerned authority, he shall be at liberty to have recourse to the other remedies as well as to approach this Court.
