On the asking of the Court, Mr. R.K.Doon, AAG, Haryana, present in court, accepts notice on behalf of the respondents. Copies furnished.

In the nature of order I propose to pass, no formal written statement(s)/counter-affidavit(s) on behalf of the respondents are indeed necessary at this stage. Thus, with the consent of the parties, the petition is being finally disposed of.

The petitioner prays for a direction to the respondents to grant him Ist ACP w.e.f. 7.3.2014, on completion of 5 years of continuous regular service, as also all other consequential benefits. The petitioner, purports to have repeatedly represented to the respondents, in this regard. But to no avail. Even the legal notice dated 28.08.2017 (Annexure P-4), the respondents have been served with, has failed to evoke any response, and

thus, the petitioner continues to suffer.

On the contrary, learned State counsel submits that the claim/grievance of the petitioner as also the legal notice dated 28.08.2017 (Annexure P-4), shall be considered and dealt with by the respondents within a period of four weeks from today and appropriate orders in accordance with law shall be passed and communicated to the petitioner.

The petition is accordingly, disposed of, in the above terms. In the event, the claim of the petitioner is declined, the respondents-authority shall afford him an opportunity of hearing and pass a comprehensive order assigning reasons in support thereof.
