The petitioner has approached this Court under Article 226 of the Constitution of India, seeking a writ in the nature of *Certiorari*, quashing the Consent to Establish dated 10.07.2014 (Annexure P-5) and Consent to Operate dated 25.09.2015 (Annexure P-9), issued by respondent No.4 in favour of respondent No.5. A further prayer for seeking direction to the respondents to comply with the directions passed by this Court in CWP No. 14933 of 2007 (Annexure P-1), the order passed by the Government of Haryana, Environment Department (Annexure P-2) and guidelines framed by the Central Pollution Control Board (Annexure P-3) has also been made.

2. After arguing for sometime, learned counsel for the petitioner states that he may be allowed to withdraw the present writ petition with liberty to the petitioner to pursue his remedies before the Civil Court, where the suit has been decreed in his favour.

3. Dismissed as withdrawn. It shall, however, be open to the petitioner to take recourse to the remedies as may be available to him, in accordance with law.
