The petitioner-Association, by way of present writ petition filed under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India, has, inter-alia, sought a writ in the nature of mandamus directing the respondents to make permanent allotments of the sites/locations to the members/retailers of the petitioner association. Further prayer has been made for restraining the respondents from illegally removing/uprooting the members of petitioner Association.

2. After arguing for some time, learned counsel for the petitioner submitted that he may be allowed to withdraw this writ petition. He, however, submits that his representation dated 07.02.2018 annexed as Annexure P-7/legal notice dated 22.02.2018 annexed as Annexure P-11, which have been filed with respondents No.3 to 5 may be decided, in accordance with law.
