JASPAL SINGH, J.

By virtue of instant writ petition preferred under Article 226 of the Constitution of India for issuance of a writ, order or direction especially a writ in the nature of Mandamus directing the respondents to release the retiral dues including pension, commuted pension, gratuity, G.P.F., Leave Encashment, GIS etc to the petitioner along with interest at the rate of 18% per annum.

2. At the very outset, learned counsel for the petitioner submitted that petitioner feels satisfied in case direction is issued to respondent No.3 to decide legal notice dated 06.12.2017 (Annexure P-2), within some stipulated period.

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3. Instant petition is disposed of with the direction to respondent No.3-Deputy Commissioner, Amritsar to look into the grievances unfolded by the petitioner in his legal notice dated 06.12.2017 (Annexure P-2) and take a conscious decision, in accordance with law, within a period of 3 months from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order.
4. However, in case, the petitioner still feels aggrieved against any of the order passed by the concerned authority, he shall be at liberty to have recourse to the other remedies available to him as well as to approach this Court.
