Instant petition has been preferred under Article 226/227 of the Constitution of India seeking issuance of a writ in the nature of mandamus, directing the respondents to release the benefits of leave encashment as per government instructions dated 12.08.1998 and 29.04.2002 (Annexures P-2 & P-3) along with 12% interest from the date of his superannuation till payment.

2. At the very outset of the arguments, learned counsel for the petitioner submits that petitioner feels satisfied in case direction is issued to respondent No.2, to decide legal notice dated 21.11.2017 (Annexure P-4), within a stipulated period.

3. Without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case, the instant petition is disposed of with the direction to respondent No.2-Director, Agriculture & Farmer Welfare Department, Haryana, Krishi Bhawan, Sector 21,

Panchkula to consider all the aspects mentioned in the legal notice dated 21.11.2017 (Annexure P-4) and take a conscious decision in accordance with law, Rules and instructions issued by government from time to time, within a period of three months from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order.

4. However, if the petitioner still feels aggrieved against any of the order(s) passed by the concerned authority, he shall be at liberty to have recourse to the other remedies as well as to approach this Court.
