This is an application filed under Section 151 Cr.P.C. for
fixing the petition to some actual early date.

For the reasons mentioned in the application, the same
is allowed.

With the consent of learned counsels for the parties, the
main petition is taken up on Board today itself.

Main Case

Learned counsel for the respondents has filed a short
reply stating that pursuant to the order dated 04.12.2018 passed by
this Court, similarly situated persons were allowed to join duties.

Copy of the reply has been supplied to learned counsel for the petitioner. Para 2 of the affidavit reflects that the process of enrolment of candidates in Indian Airforce for intake 01/2019 was concluded on 14.11.2018. Learned counsel for the respondents contends that the petitioner at this stage cannot be allowed to join duties. He states that even call letters were issued and despatched to all the eligible candidates in IAF for intake 1/2019. He, however, states that the petitioner would be considered for the subsequent batch subject to fulfilment of the eligibility conditions in accordance with law.

In view thereof, learned counsel for the petitioner states that petitioner would be satisfied if he is considered for the subsequent batch.

Accordingly, the present writ petition is dismissed keeping in view the stand taken by learned counsel for the respondents.
