JASPAL SINGH, J. (ORAL)

Through the instant civil writ petition, preferred under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India, petitioners have sought the issuance of a writ especially in the nature of Mandamus directing the respondents to count the qualifying service of the petitioners from the date of joining in the Corporation and recalculate the retiral dues of the petitioners and to release the same along with interest @ 18% per annum as well as to release the arrears and revised pensionary benefits.

2. Learned counsel for the petitioners submits that though the petitioners moved the representation to the Managing Director, PRTC, Head Office, Patiala seeking recalculation of retiral dues from the date of their joining into service instead of date calculated by PRTC and also to give interest on delayed payments. But no decision has been taken so far by the

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concerned authority. Learned counsel for the petitioners further submits that they feels satisfied in case a direction is issued to respondent to decide their representation dated March 08, 2017 (P-6) within some specified period.

3. Without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case, instant petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent to look into the grievances unfolded by the petitioners in their representation dated March 08, 2017 (P-6) and to take a conscious decision by passing a speaking order, within a period of three months from the date of receipt of a certified copy of this order. In case, non compliance of this order, petitioners shall be at liberty to approach this Court.
