The petitioner competed for selection to the post of MPHW (Female) under the Scheduled Caste Category. Pursuant to an interim order, dated 05.03.2018, passed by this Court, she was required to be interviewed provisionally by the respondents and they were restrained from pronouncing her results.

Today, the learned State counsel has brought the results of the petitioner in a sealed cover, which has since been opened. And it reveals that the last candidate, who has been selected in the category of the petitioner, had obtained 110 marks, whereas the petitioner had secured 104 marks i.e. 84 in the written examination and 20 marks in the interview. A photocopy of the results has been taken on record as "Mark A", and another copy thereof has been furnished to the learned counsel for the petitioner.

Faced with this, learned counsel for the petitioner submits that nothing substantive survives in this petition and the same be disposed of as having rendered infructuous.

Ordered, accordingly.
