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Main Cases

All these writ petitions are being taken up together to avoid the repetitions and the questions of law as well as facts being identical.

The petitioners in all the writ petitions are retired employees of Pepsu Road Transport Corporation, Nabha Road, Patiala (for short, 'PRTC') who have claimed interest on the delayed payment made to them on account of pension or pensionary benefits i.e. Gratuity, Leave Encashment, Provident Fund and grant of ACP's etc.

The question involved in these matters is no more res integra as has already been dealt with and disposed of by this Court while in CWP No.15306 of 2016 titled as ***Hari Ram & ors. vs. Pepsu Road Transport Corporation, Nabha Road, Patiala***, decided on September 04, 2017.

These petitions are squarely covered within the parameters laid down in the aforesaid judgment dated September 04, 2017. Moreover, during the course of arguments, learned counsel for the respondents has also fairly conceded that the controversy involved in these petitions has already been set at rest by this Court.

Accordingly, all these petitions stand disposed of in terms of the judgment in CWP No.15306 of 2016 titled as ***Hari Ram & ors. vs. Pepsu Road Transport Corporation, Nabha Road, Patiala***, decided on September 04, 2017.
