The petitioner, claiming to be a public spirited person, has approached this Court under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India, inter-alia, seeking a writ in the nature of mandamus for directing the respondents to take action against the person who are illegally taking the sand from the bank of river from Satluj river bed of other villages without any permission from the competent authority. Further prayer has been made for restraining the respondents mafia/mining contractors from mining after sun set which cause danger to the land of the village.

2. After arguing for some time, learned counsel for the petitioner submitted that he may be allowed to withdraw this writ petition, with liberty to file fresh one, on the same cause of action as inadvertently certain material facts have not been incorporated and necessary documents added with the instant writ petition.

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3. Dismissed as withdrawn with the aforesaid liberty.
