Reply on behalf of respondents no. 1 and 2 has been filed in the Court today and the same is taken on record. A copy thereof has been supplied to the counsel opposite.

On 6.3.2018, we had passed the following order, after noticing the grievance of the petitioner:-

“Contentends that warrant of possession has been issued pursuant to the orders passed by the Assistant Collector on 5.2.2007 which order was set aside by the Commissioner, Gurgaon Division on 15.9.2011 remanding the proceedings back to the Assistant Collector for decision afresh but no proceedings took place thereafter. It is thus contended that in the absence of any fresh order warrant of possession cannot be

executed by relying on an order which effectively stands negated in appropriate proceedings.

Notice of motion for 02.05.2018.

In the meantime, status quo with regard to possession be maintained.”

In para 6 of the aforesaid reply it is stated that warrants of possession have been withdrawn and possession would be taken in accordance with law.

In view of above, instant petition has been rendered infructuous and the same is disposed of as such.
