In the nature of order I propose to pass, no formal written
statement(s)/counter-affidavit(s) on behalf of the respondents are indeed
necessary at this stage. Thus, with the consent of the parties, the petition is
being finally disposed of.

The petitioner competed for selection to the post of Station
Supervisor, under the Ex-servicemen BC-B category. He purports to have
qualified the written examination, and was even called for scrutiny of
documents. However, in the list of short-listed candidates, who were called
for interview, name and roll number of the petitioner was not reflected.
Concededly, interviews were conducted on 22.2.2018, and the process has
since been concluded. It is urged that the petitioner possessed the requisite
qualification and experience, and was fully eligible to be considered for
selection, but for some intangible reasons, his claim has since been ignored.

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He purports to have even served the respondents with a representation dated 15.2.2018 (Annexure P-11). But to no avail.

In response, learned State counsel submits that the claim/grievance of the petitioner as also his representation, dated 15.2.2018 (Annexure P-11), shall be considered and dealt with within a period of six weeks from today. And appropriate orders, in accordance with law, shall be passed.

The petition is accordingly disposed of, in the above terms. However, in the event the claim of the petitioner is declined, the respondent authorities shall pass a comprehensive order assigning reasons in support thereof.
