Prayer in this application is for condonation of delay of 1065 days in filing the appeal.

In view of the averments made in the application supported by affidavit of Smt. Vidya Devi, widow of the deceased coupled with the factum that the provisions of Motor Vehicles Act, 1988 providing for compensation are benevolent social legislation, application is allowed and delay of 1065 days in filing the appeal is condoned subject to the condition that the claimant shall forgo interest for the period of delay in case compensation is enhanced.
