Through instant petition preferred under Article 226/227 of the Constitution of India, petitioner has sought issuance of a writ particularly in the nature of mandamus, directing the respondents to grant extra-ordinary family pension w.e.f. the date of death of her husband with all consequential benefits AND further directing the respondents to grant Ex-Gratia lumpsum compensation, Central Welfare Risk Fund, GPF, Deposit Linked Insurance, Central Government employee's Group Insurance along with interest @ 18% per annum.

2. Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that husband of the petitioner namely Rameshwar Dayal was appointed as Constable in CISF and died due to fall from the Tower while performing the duty on May 02, 2000. He further contends that though a Justice Demand Notice was made to the respondents on August 29, 2016 (P-1) but till date no conscious

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decision has been taken so far. Further he feels satisfied in case a direction is issued to respondent No.2 to decide the aforesaid Justice Demand Notice (P-1) in a time bound manner.

3. Without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case, the instant petition is disposed of with the direction to respondent No.2 to look into the grievances unfolded by the petitioner in the legal notice Justice Demand Notice dated August 29, 2016 (P-1) and to decide the same as per Rules, Regulations and instructions issued by the Government from time to time, within a period of two months from the date of receipt of a certified copy of this order. In case of non compliance of this order, petitioner shall be at liberty to have recourse to the remedies available to her as well as to approach this Court.
