1. Feeling aggrieved by the intimation (Annexure P-5), the petitioner has approached this Court by filing a writ petition under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India for issuance of a writ in the nature of certiorari for quashing the intimation (Annexure P-5). Further prayer has been made by the petitioner for issuance of a writ of mandamus directing the respondents to issue the conveyance deed to the petitioner in lieu of the allotment of plot No. 20, Sector-4, Urban Estate, Rohtak.

2. Learned counsel for the petitioner prays that liberty be granted to the petitioner to file a detailed and comprehensive representation before the appropriate authority by incorporating the grievance as raised in the

present writ petition and a direction be issued to the authority concerned to decide the representation expeditiously in a time bound manner in accordance with law.

3. After hearing learned counsel for the petitioner, perusing the present writ petition and without commenting anything on the merits of the case, we dispose of the present petition by granting liberty to the petitioner to file a detailed and comprehensive representation, raising all the pleas as raised in the present writ petition before respondent No. 2 within 15 days from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order. It is directed that in the event of a representation being filed by the petitioner within the aforesaid period, the same shall be decided by the said authority by passing a speaking order and after affording an opportunity of hearing to the petitioner within next one month in accordance with law.
