Perusal of the interim order shows that the petitioner had filed petition for extension of parole from 08.03.2018 to 08.07.2018. That period has also expired. There is no prayer for further extension on the ground that he is still suffering from cancer.

Counsel appearing for the petitioner submits that arguing counsel is unwell and his presence may not be marked.

Case considered.

This Court vide order dated 06.03.2018 extended the parole till 12.03.2018 on the bail bonds already submitted. On 03.05.2018, it was further extended till 07.05.2018. On 07.05.2018, counsel for the petitioner was not present, therefore, no order for extension of parole was granted. On 28.05.2018 also none appears for the petitioner and order for extension

of parole was not granted. Therefore, the petitioner is availing the parole without any specific order. Result is that the petitioner has not surrendered before the authorities. Prayer in the present case was for extension of parole from 08.03.2018 to 08.07.2018 and the said time has already expired. Therefore the present petition has already become infructuous.

Petitioner is directed to surrender immediately before the jail authorities to face the consequences of not surrendering without any order of extension from this court.

Petition is disposed of as infructuous.
