By way of the present petition, the petitioner seeks issuance of directions to respondent No.3 to decide the statutory departmental appeal dated 30.11.2016 (Annexure P-2), filed by the petitioner against the order dated 26.08.2016 (Annexure P-1).

Heard.

In view of the above, without advertting to the merits of the case, the present petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No.3 to consider and decide the statutory appeal dated 30.11.2016 (Annexure P-2) within a period of six weeks from the date of receipt of certified copy of the order. In case, on consideration, the competent authority reaches to the conclusion that the benefit claimed by the petitioner is admissible to him, in such eventuality, the consequential relief be allowed to him, within a period of three months thereafter. However, in case the competent authority feels that the relief claimed by

the petitioner is not admissible or made out, in that case, a speaking order be passed in the matter.
