The prayer in the present petition is for extension of parole, which has already been granted to the petitioner by the jail authority for a period of three weeks enabling him to take care of his wife who is stated to be seriously ill for the last more than three weeks.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that wife of the petitioner is still seriously ill and she has been advised bed rest. He prays that the parole period may be extended for a period of three weeks further.

On perusal of medical prescription dated 03.03.2018 (Annexure P-2), it shows that no bed rest has been advised by the doctor. Neither the condition of the petitioner has been reflected in the document nor any other document has been placed on record to show that condition of wife of the petitioner is serious.

No ground is made out to extend the period of parole.

Dismissed.

However, the petitioner is directed to surrender on expiry of period of parole. He is at liberty to apply fresh to jail authorities in case any cause of action survives.
