Aggrieved by dismissal of his petition for divorce, husband has preferred this appeal. During pendency of appeal, parties appear to have amicably settled the controversies by signing a settlement agreement Ex.CX dated 26.02.2018. As per the terms of said settlement, both the parties have agreed to withdraw their respective litigations/proceedings and part company by filing a divorce petition under Section 13-B of Hindu Marriage Act.

Counsel for the appellant informs that a divorce petition under Section 13-B of Hindu Marriage Act, as per the terms settled, has been filed before the District Judge, Gurgaon.

In view of said circumstances, the instant appeal is dismissed of as having rendered infructuous. Settlement Ex.CX is made part of the

record. In case of violation of any terms of the settlement, it will be open to the parties to approach this Court for restoration of the proceedings.
