On the asking of the Court, Mr. Siddharth Sanwaria, DAG, Haryana, present in court, accepts notice on behalf of the respondent. Copy furnished.

In the nature of order I propose to pass, no formal written statement(s)/counter-affidavit(s) on behalf of the respondent is indeed necessary at this stage. Thus, with the consent of the parties, the petition is being finally disposed of.

The petitioner competed for selection to the post of Post Graduate Teacher (PGT), Computer Science, under the general category (Paper Code-B). He purports to have qualified the written examination and was called for scrutiny of documents. The limited grievance that the petitioner has is: that the sample answer-key was uploaded by the Commission on its website on 21.05.2016, and vide notice of an even date

(Annexure P-8), the candidates were required to file objections thereto. The petitioner alleged to have filed objection dated 23.05.2016, to the sample answer-key within the stipulated time. But his grievance is; that without considering those objections the Commission has rather uploaded the revised answerkey (Annexure P-10). Further, even to the revised answer key, the petitioner purports to have filed objection on 15.01.2018, which too have not been dealt with. It is urged that the process of selection is still at an early stage, for, even the schedule for interview has not been notified, therefore, the respondents be directed to decide the objections filed by the petitioner.

In response, learned counsel for the respondent submits that the claim/grievance of the petitioner shall be considered and dealt with by the respondent before the interviews are held. And, appropriate orders in accordance with law shall be passed.

The petition is accordingly disposed of, in the above terms.
