In the nature of order I propose to pass, no formal written
statement(s)/counter-affidavit(s) on behalf of the respondents are indeed
necessary at this stage. Thus, with the consent of learned counsel for the
parties, the petition is being finally disposed of.

The petitioner competed for selection to the post of Heavy
Vehicle Driver, in the Outstanding Sports Person (General) Category, against
20 posts, that were reserved under the said category. He purports to have
qualified the written examination as also the driving proficiency test, and
was even called for interview, that was held w.e.f 25.2.2018 to 1.3.2018. It
is urged that only 12 candidates, in the category of the petitioner, were called
for interview, including the petitioner, and he being fully eligible, there

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could not be any reason to ignore his candidature for selection and consequential appointment. Concededly, the process of selection has been concluded and even the appointments have since been made on 4.3.2018. But, the precise grievance that the petitioner has is; that for some intangible reason, his claim has been ignored.

In response, learned counsel for the respondents submits that claim/grievance of the petitioner shall be considered and dealt with within a period of three weeks from today. And appropriate orders, in accordance with law, shall be passed and communicated to the petitioner.

The petition is accordingly disposed of, in the above terms. In the event, claim of the petitioner is declined, the respondent authorities shall pass a comprehensive order assigning reasons in support thereof.
