JITENDRA CHAUHAN, J.

The present petitioner under Article 226 of the Constitution of India has been filed for issuing direction to the respondents to release the salary of the petitioners w.e.f. October, 2017 and also to deposit the provident funds arrears in their GPF accounts.

Learned counsel for respondent No.3 on telephonic instructions from Jatinder, Executive Officer, Municipal Council, Qadian states that the entire salary due to the petitioners has been paid on 3.5.2018. Copies of the bank drafts alongwith the bills are taken on record as Mark 'A'. However, the issue with regard to deposit of arrears of provident funds in their GPF accounts is under consideration.

In view of the above, the substantial relief has been allowed to

the petitioners and the second issue i.e. to deposit the arrears of provident funds in their GPF accounts, the respondents are directed to consider the same as per law and pass a speaking order within six weeks from the date of receipt of the certified copy of this order. In case, the petitioners are not satisfied with the order so passed, they shall have the liberty either to revive the present petition or to file fresh within three thereafter.

Disposed of accordingly.
