1. The petitioner has approached this Court, under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India, for issuance of a writ in the nature of mandamus, directing the respondents to take immediate action against the violations made by the Hotels as per the recommendations of detailed Survey Report submitted by the Senior Town Planner, Municipal Corporation, Ludhiana to the Chief Town Planner, Department of Local Body, Chandigarh.

2. Learned counsel for the petitioner submitted that the Hotels which are likely to be affected by the relief claimed by the petitioner in the writ petition, have inadvertently been missed to be made as party-respondents. Accordingly, a prayer was made that he be permitted to withdraw the writ petition with liberty to the petitioner to file fresh one on the same cause of action, by impleading proper and necessary parties.

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3. Dismissed as withdrawn with the aforesaid liberty.
