CWP No. 5670 of 2018

By virtue of instant petition, preferred under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India, petitioners have sought a writ in the nature of mandamus directing the respondents to grant them the amount of leave encashment, along-with interest @ 12% per annum.

2. At the very outset, learned counsel for the petitioners submits that though legal notice dated 27.09.2017 (Annexure P-5) was duly served upon the respondents but till date no conscious decision has been taken. He further

submits that petitioners feels satisfied in case a direction is issued to respondent No.2 to decide afore-said legal notice, within some prescribed period.

3. Without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case, the instant petition is disposed of with the direction to respondent No.2-The Secretary, State Consumer Disputes Redressal Commission, Haryana, Bays No. 3-6, Sector 4, Panchkula, to look into the grievances unfolded by the petitioners in legal notice dated 27.09.2017 (Annexure P-5) and to decide the same as per Rules particularly in the light of judgment passed in CWP No. 5773 of 2015, titled as **“Om Parkash vs. State of Haryana & others;**, decided on 28.02.2017 (P-7), which has attained finality and stood implemented as is evident from the letter dated 19.06.2017 (P-8), within a period of 3 months from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order.

4. However, if the petitioners still feel aggrieved against any of the order(s) passed by the concerned authority, they shall be at liberty to have recourse to the other remedies available to them as well as to approach this Court.
