The petitioner competed for selection to the post of Grid Sub Station Operator in ESM (General) Category. He appeared in the written examination, but was not called for scrutiny of documents, that was carried out w.e.f. 19.3.2017 to 21.3.2017. His case is; that in the list of the short-listed candidates, published on 23.2.2018, called for interview, the last candidate, in the category of the petitioner, had obtained 48 marks. Whereas, as per self assessment of his OMR sheet and the answer key, uploaded by the Commission on its website, the petitioner had obtained 52 marks. It is urged that interview is slated to take place on 10.3.2018, and in the event, the petitioner is not permitted to participate, he shall suffer an incalculable loss.

Notice of motion.

Mr. Hitesh Pandit, Additional A.G. Haryana, present in court, accepts notice on behalf of the respondent. Copy supplied.

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Learned State counsel submits that claim/grievance of the petitioner shall be considered and dealt with. And appropriate orders, in accordance with law, shall be passed today itself and communicated to the petitioner as also to his counsel.

The petition is accordingly disposed of, in the above terms. In the event, claim of the petitioner is declined, the respondent authorities shall pass a comprehensive order assigning reasons in support thereof. On the contrary, if the petitioner is found suitable and, rather, ought to have been called for interview, intimation in this regard shall be sent to him in time, to enable him to participate in the interview.
