On the asking of the Court, Mr. Sunil Kumar Sharma,
Advocate accepts notice on behalf of the respondents.

All the above mentioned petitions are being disposed of by
this order.

Heard.

The claim of the petitioner for promotion from the date the
junior was promoted in the year 1986 has been declined by the
Resident Engineer, WYC HE Project, HPGCL Bhudkalan whereas the
competent authority to pass an order would be respondent No.2 i.e.
The Chief Engineer, Haryana Power Generation Corporation Limited,
DCRTPP, Yamunanagar (Haryana) as held by this court in similar case
CWP No. 5100 of 2018, Sukhdev Singh Vs. Haryana Power
Generation Corporation Limited and others decided on 01.03.2018.

It may be noticed that the junior was promoted in the year
2017 with retrospective effect in the year 1986 and, therefore, it is
urged by the learned counsel for the petitioner that even question of
delay and latches does not arise.

Without expressing any opinion, the grievance is remitted
to the competent authority respondent No.2 i.e. The Chief Engineer-
HPGCL to pass a speaking order in accordance with law within a

period of three months from the date of receiving of certified copy of the order. Needless to say that the impugned order passed by the Resident Engineer is set aside to make way for passing a fresh order.

With these observations and directions, the petition is disposed of.
