ARUN PALLI, J. (Oral)

The petitioner was employed as Sweeper-cum-Mali as back as on 1.4.1996. Pursuant to an order dated 25.8.2014 (Annexure P-8), her services were regularised from the said date. The limited grievance that she has is; that as her claim for regularisation was, indeed, covered by the policy dated 27.2.2004 (Annexure P-4), therefore, her services were, rather, required to be regularised w.e.f. 27.2.2004. Particularly, when one Mohinder Singh, who was appointed much later than the petitioner, has been regularised w.e.f. 27.2.2004. The petitioner purports to have repeatedly represented to the respondents in this regard. But to no avail. Even the representation, dated 23.8.2017 (Annexure P-9), as also the legal notice, dated 7.10.2017 (Annexure P-10), the respondents have been served with, have failed to evoke any response.

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That being so, the petition is disposed of, at this stage, only with a direction to respondents No. 1 to 3, to consider and decide the claim/grievance of the petitioner as also her representation, dated 23.8.2017 (Annexure P-9)/legal notice, dated 7.10.2017 (Annexure P-10) within a period of eight weeks from the receipt of a certified copy of this order. And, pass appropriate orders in accordance with law. In the event, the claim of the petitioner is declined, the authority shall pass a comprehensive order assigning reasons in support thereof.
