In the nature of order I propose to pass, no formal written
statement(s)/counter-affidavit(s) on behalf of the respondents are indeed
necessary at this stage. Thus, with the consent of the learned counsel for the
parties, the petition is being disposed of finally.

The petitioners competed for selection to the post of Heavy
Vehicle Drivers, under the General Category. They purport to have qualified
the written examination as also the driving proficiency test. However, they
were not called for interview, which was held w.e.f. 25.2.2018 to 1.3.2018.
The limited grievance that they have is; that for some intangible reason, their
claims have since been ignored by the respondents.

In response, learned State counsel submits that claim/grievance of the petitioners shall be considered and dealt with within a period of two weeks from today. And appropriate orders, in accordance with law, shall be passed.

The petition is accordingly disposed of, in the above terms. In the event, claim of the petitioners is declined, the respondent authorities shall pass a comprehensive order assigning reasons in support thereof.
