Although the petitioner has approached this Court seeking a direction to respondents no.1 to 4 to cancel the revised certificate of registration dated 12.05.2017 issued in terms of the provisions of the Haryana Registration and Regulation of Societies Act, 2012 (hereinafter referred to as the "Act") yet he has confined his prayer for the issuance of a direction to respondent no.4 to whom the petitioner has already filed an application/petition in terms of Section 59 of the Act for the purpose of cancellation of registration certificate. It is also submitted that though under Section 59 of the Act, the power vests with the Registrar but respondent no.4 has been delegated the powers for the purpose of deciding such type of applications.

Accordingly, the present petition is hereby disposed of with a direction to respondent no.4 to proceed with the decision on the representation/application dated 06.11.2017 in accordance with the provisions of Section 59 of the Act and try to decide the same as early as possible preferably within a period of 3 months from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order.
