This writ petition under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India has been filed for the issuance of a writ, in the nature of mandamus directing the respondents to re-fix the seniority of the petitioner in the sports category in view of the Punjab Govt. Notification dated 18.05.2011 (Annexure P-1) and the clarificatory notification dated 14.06.2011 (Annexure P-2) as claimed in representations dated 04.10.2013 and 20.04.2015 (Annexures P-3 and P-4 respectively) and legal notice dated 24.01.2018 (Annexure P-7).

Learned counsel for the petitioner states that at this stage he would be satisfied, if a direction is issued to respondent No.2-Director General of Police, Punjab, Deluxe Building, Mini Secretariat, Punjab, Sector-9, Chandigarh to consider and decide the legal notice dated 24.01.2018 (Annexure P-7).

Heard.

In view of the above, without adverting to the merits of the case, the present petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No.2- Director General of Police, Punjab, Deluxe Building, Mini Secretariat, Punjab, Sector-9, Chandigarh to consider and decide the legal notice dated 24.01.2018 (Annexure P-7) within six weeks from the receipt of the certified copy of the order. In case, on consideration, the competent authority reaches to the conclusion that the benefit claimed by the petitioner is admissible to him, in such eventuality, the consequential relief be allowed to him, within a period of six weeks thereafter. However, in case the competent authority feels that the relief claimed by the petitioner is not admissible or made out, in that case, a speaking order be passed in the matter.
