By virtue of instant petition preferred under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India, petitioner has sought a writ in the nature of mandamus directing the respondents to grant her family pension, along-with interest @18% per annum, on account of death of her husband.

2. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the husband of the petitioner died in harness on April 08, 2013. He further submits that though a representation dated October 05, 2017 (P-7) was moved to respondents No 2 and 3 but till date neither any reply has been received nor any action has been taken. He further submits that he feels satisfied in case a direction is issued to respondent No.2 to consider and decide the representation (P-7) within a stipulated period.

3. Accordingly, instant petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No.2 to consider and decide the representation (P-7) in accordance

with law, rules, regulations and instructions issued by the Government from time to time as well as in view of judgments passed by Hon'ble Division Bench of this Court in CWP No. 2371 of 2010, titled as **Harbans Lal vs. The State of Punjab and others;** decided on August 31, 2010 (P-4) and by this Court in CWP No. 11802 of 2008, titled as **Paramjit Kaur vs. The State of Punjab and others;** decided on May 11, 2016 (P-5) and CWP No. 16918 of 2015, titled as **Ranju vs. State of Punjab and others;** decided on November 04, 2016 (P-6), within a period of three months from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order.

4. However, in case petitioner still feels aggrieved, she shall be at liberty to have recourse to the other remedies available to her under law including to approach this Court.
