This writ petition under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India has been filed for the issuance of a writ, in the nature of mandamus directing respondent Nos.3 and 4 to consider the claim of the petitioner and grant him one extra mark for educational qualification.

Contentends that the petitioner has not been allowed adequate marks for the educational qualification as has been allowed in case of Darshan Singh who is shown at S.No.638 in the merit list (Annexure P-5) and many others. He further states that at this stage he would be satisfied, if a direction is issued to respondent No.3- Director General of Police (Jails), Department of Prisons, Government of Punjab, Sector-17, Chandigarh to consider and decide the representation dated 30.01.2018 (Annexure P-6).

Heard.

In view of the above, without advertting to the merits of the case, the present petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No.3-

Director General of Police (Jails), Department of Prisons, Government of Punjab, Sector-17, Chandigarh to consider and decide the representation dated 30.01.2018 (Annexure P-6) within six weeks from the receipt of the certified copy of the order. In case, on consideration, the competent authority reaches to the conclusion that the benefit claimed by the petitioner is admissible to him, in such eventuality, the consequential relief be allowed to him, within a period of six weeks thereafter. However, in case the competent authority feels that the relief claimed by the petitioner is not admissible to him or made out, in that case, a speaking order be passed in the matter.
