Prayer made in the present writ petition is for release of provisional pension which has been stopped w.e.f. November, 2017 and further to release the benefits of leave encashment and gratuity amount.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contended that as per his information, the pension of the petitioner has been stopped on the ground that some criminal proceedings are pending against him by way of appeal before the appellate Court, but by now, the respondents have not passed any order for stoppage of pension and there is no justified ground for doing so. Reliance on this point was placed on the law laid down by the Hon'ble Full Bench of this Court in case “**Punjab State Civil Supplies Corporation Ltd and others vs. Pyare Lal, 2012(4) RSJ 616** (Annexure P2)”.

Learned counsel for the petitioner further contended that the grievance of the petitioner would be redressed if his legal notice dated

In view of the above, the present writ petition is disposed of with direction to respondent No.2 to look into and decide the legal notice dated 15.12.2017 (Annexure P4) expeditiously and preferably within a period of three months.
